

Blood Services Update • Zika Testing

Effective Date: 11 AUG 2021

Discontinuation of Zika Testing

As of May 12, 2021, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has withdrawn its July 2018 Zika virus (ZIKV) testing guidance, stating that "testing for ZIKV, or pathogen reduction as an alternative to testing for ZIKV, is not necessary to comply with the requirements of 21 CFR 610.40(a)(3)." The agency determined that ZIKV is no longer a relevant transfusion-transmitted infection (RTTI) under FDA's regulations because the virus no longer has sufficient incidence and/or prevalence to affect the potential donor population.
